Footnotes

CARESSING, rated in behind the leaders from early on, saved ground for six furlongs, came out six wide at the quarter-mile ground to make a sweeping run, reached the front nearing the final furlong, then was hard ridden the remainder to hold PLATINUM TIARA safe. The latter, within striking distance from the outset, edged up behind a wall of horses in the upper stretch, angled inside CARESSING in the final furlong, finished willingly but couldn't make up the difference. SHE'S A DEVIL DUE, outrun early, worked her way inside, saved ground until approaching the final quarter, swung out eight wide for the drive and finished with good energy. CINDY'S HERO drifted out at the start bumping soundly with OUT OF SYNC, reached contention in behind rivals upon going six furlongs, then offered a mild gain in the drive while continuing in behind rivals four wide. NOTABLE CAREER went up early to stalk the pace three or four wide in hand, made her run entering the stretch from that position on the track, reached the front briefly between calls, then weakened. RAGING FEVER, in hand early while following the leaders within easy striking distance five wide, was asked for her best nearing the final quarter, gained about even terms for the lead when straightened for the drive but flattened out late. THUNDER BERTIE nicely maneuvered her way inside on the first turn to gain the lead, went along under careful handling while showing the way until the stretch and weakened. NASTY STORM gained a forward position inside early, saved ground in a striking position until the stretch and faded when straightened for the drive. OUT OF SYNC, bumped at the start and forced out, was checked, then failed to menace. XTRA HEAT, checked lightly soon after the start when CASH DEAL stumbled to her inside, was never prominent. STORMY PICK tired early.

CASH DEAL went to her knees at the start, struck her nose on the ground and lost all chance.
