Footnotes

HARLAN'S HOLIDAY leaned in at the start bumping SHINING CAREER, quickly was straightened and moved up to track front-running SHOWMEITALL five wide, advanced to the fore just after going six furlongs, edged clear, then was kept to his task in the drive. REQUEST FOR PAROLE bobbed sharply at the start, was eased off the inside soon after to race five wide, made a bold run from that position on the track approaching the stretch, loomed a solid threat outside HARLAN'S HOLIDAY for the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response as second best. GOLD DOLLAR settled in behind rivals early, edged up four or five wide on the turn, came out six wide to make a run into the final furlong but failed to sustain the needed momentum. JANADEL (IRE) was taken off the inside early, raced between horses four or five wide into the stretch, angled to the rail at the furlong grounds and couldn't seriously threaten while improving position. SHINING CAREER, bumped by the winner soon after the start, continued inward and exchanged bumps with TRAIL, was outrun for six furlongs, came out six or seven wide for the drive and failed to offer a final response. SHOWMEITALL sprinted clear early, made the pace four wide until the stretch and tired. YOGA, in contention while four wide from the early on, weakened approaching the final quarter. NATIVE MARK, badly outrun from the beginning, moved inside but failed to reach contention. TRAIL came out at the break exchanging bumps with SHINING CAREER, then never menaced. PHARAOH'S CAT, well placed from the start near the inside, raced in contention for six furlongs and faded.
