Footnotes

ARTEMUS SUNRISE gained a slight edge at the start, dueled with MINISTERS WILD CAT while outside that one four or five wide, put him away entering the stretch, moved clear and was kept to his task. WITHOUT A DOUBT, never far back, raced in behind horses to the stretch, eased out four or five wide for the drive and couldn't threaten the winner late as second best. ENGINEERED, outrun for a half while racing in behind horses, came out seven or eight wide for the drive and offered a minor gain. MINISTERS WILD CAT contested the pace inside the winner until the stretch and weakened gradually. RUBA DUB DUB followed the leaders within easy striking distance five wide into the final furlong and came up empty. SCAT SAM MAN, close up between foes early, remained a forward factor while coming out five wide into the lane and weakened when the test came. FOUNDING CHAIRMAN, close up inside early, was in tight along the rail leaving the backstretch and weakened gradually.
