Footnotes

MAYAN PRINCESS, never far back, commenced a sweeping rally six wide leaving the five-sixteenths pole, engaged LUCKY ONE while coming slightly wider in the upper stretch and proved best under urging. LUCKY ONE, outrun for a half, accelerated steadily five wide nearing the stretch, gained a slim lead, then was outfished in a long drive. SUGARLESS battled for the lead from near the inside between foes early, showed the way into the stretch and couldn't continue. BARK ALLEY vied for the lead from early on while near the inside between foes, lost position nearing the stretch, then dug in at the end to best the rest while not a threat. PICTURE QUE forced the pace from early on while three abreast, continued forwardly to the stretch and weakened. POLLY LYNCH, outrun to the lane, never menaced while slightly improving position. ME R. U. gained a forward position early while five or six wide, raced within easy striking distance to the stretch and came up empty. NATONEA settled near the inside, swung out eight wide into the stretch and failed to menace. AZTEC broke slowly in a tangle, was steadied and not a factor. SANDTINA attended the pace inside to the turn and weakened gradually. IMBALI was outrun and ten wide in the drive.
