SUGAR SWIRL forced the pace four wide, reached the front a quarter-mile out, kicked clear and was kept to her task. GENEROSITY ducked out at the start, recovered to race within striking distance five wide, then couldn't threaten the winner late while earning the place. COUNTRY DIVA vied for the lead from between horses, dueled on even terms into the stretch and weakened. EXCELLERANT broke slowly and hit the gate, was outrun four wide to the stretch, made a mild run into the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. HUMOROUS GAL, outrun to the stretch and racing near the inside, continued from the rail and improved position while not a serious threat. ADHRHYTHM raced two or three wide most of the way and failed to rally. MORNER, four or five wide, was empty in the drive. G CITY GAL battled for the lead along the inside to the final quarter and faltered.
