Footnotes

TALK TO NICK opened clear to dictate terms, repelled the challenge leaving the second turn and widened through the drive. ROCK HARD was unhurried into stride, ranged into striking distance three deep through the second turn, continued the advance from between rivals into the lane, shifted out for the final furlong and finished well to earn the place. BELL BUCKLE prompted the pace along the inside through the first turn, angled to the outside of TALK TO NICK before going a half, was unable to match strides with that one after six furlongs, weakened further in the drive and just held the show. RIDETHEHIGHCOUNTRY settled in hand, advanced from between horses through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. NAICHE was close up from between horses, got through entering the stretch but failed to sustain the drive. SEAL OF THE PEARL chased the pace four wide, but tired entering the stretch and faded. COACHTHECHIP was pinched back at the start, settled saving ground but lacked a response when called upon. NEXT MAY settled in the second flight four wide and failed to respond. TALK IT OUT angled in and was forwardly placed along the rail, took closer order through the second turn, got through entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive and retreated. FRENCH SADLER showed little. LONOMAKUA was always outrun. STONE EAGLE was hung wide for a half, stopped and was distanced through the lane.
