### Footnotes

LADY CHARLIE settled in hand, ranged into striking distance four wide through the turn, caught TAPITFORPAR inside the furlong marker and quickly drew clear. JUDYINLIGHTS angled in to save ground, got through entering the stretch, was walled in behind rivals and steadied near the furlong marker, altered course to the outside and finished well once clear. NEON LIPSTICK was unhurried into stride, commenced her bid leaving the turn, swung to the outside for the final furlong and was making up ground willingly. SKY FUSE was allowed to settle, moved with the winner three wide through the turn, was blocked and steadied near the three-sixteenths pole and went evenly through the drive. GAELIC LASS attended the pace along the inside, shifted out to make her bid between horses with a quarter to run but lacked the needed late response. INDEMAND was unhurried, came four wide to make a belated gain but failed to threaten. TAPITFORPAR bobbled at the start, rushed to the lead between horses, disputed the pace to the final furlong but gave way readily once headed. ANDREA LOUISE stalked the pace three wide, drew even entering the turn, but weakened after six furlongs and faded. ASIAN PROVERB was away alertly, contested the pace along the inside through the turn and tired. KLEA stumbled at the start and unseated her jockey.
