Footnotes

HELLO SAILOR was unprepared at the start and away behind his field, circled nine wide to make his bid, came to level terms inside the sixteenth pole, bumped with GRUENEWALD late and was all out to narrowly prevail. GRUENEWALD was slow into stride, moved with the winner through the turn, came eight wide to continue the advance, was jostled between horses when GHOST CHAPEL floated out late, squeezed through but just missed. GHOST CHAPEL was allowed to settle off of the inside, angled out six wide to launched his move, drew even inside the furlong marker, drifted out under left handed

urging, bumped GRUENEWALD and grudgingly gave way. ROMAN ALONG contended between horses, split rivals and loomed a danger but flattened during the drive. JUSTANOTHERJOE settled saving ground, angled out leaving the turn and improved position between horses. COFFEE BOY stalked the pace, bid between horses, edged clear leaving the turn, angled to the inside entering the stretch and faltered during the drive. LARRY'S VISION was allowed to settle, shifted out leaving the turn, offered a mild bid between horses six wide but failed to sustain the drive. AMAZING SPIRIT was allowed to settle, moved up six wide but came up empty entering the stretch. HERO'S EMPIRE was close up five wide, drew even after a half but tired entering the lane. ZAK BENATE was through after a half. GREEN MOUSE pressed three wide for a half and dropped out. BLINGBOY set the pressured pace between horses, then inside, was headed after a half and stopped. The jockey of GRUENEWALD lodged an objection against HELLO SAILOR for alleged interference in deep stretch, but following the review the Stewards made no change to the order of finish.
