CLOSE CUT, bothered at the start, recovered to race within striking distance, moved closer before a half, challenged from the outside entering the stretch and drew clear under steady urging. IDOL GIFT, reserved early, commenced her rally three wide with three furlongs to go but lacked the needed late bid. EXCELLENTADVENTURE came in at the start to bother inner rivals, vied for the lead out in the strip and held on well in the drive. LANCELOT'S LADY, behind the leaders, was four wide past the three furlong marker and lacked a late bid. ITSY BITSY BETSY, never far back off the rail, had little left in the drive. KIZZIE, never far back along the inside, tired in the drive. MER DE GLACE, bothered at the start, was outrun to the stretch and found her best stride too late. STEALTH vied for the lead off the inside and gave way in the drive. LOMATIC, within striking distance four wide, raced five wide on the turn and faded.
