Footnotes

BRAHMS settled in behind the leaders early, advanced between foes on the turn, rallied inside front-running VERGENNES and wore that one down in the late stages. VERGENNES gained the lead early, made the pace into the final furlong but couldn't handle BRAHMS in the the late going. SUPER QUERCUS (FR) saved ground from the start, followed the winner three wide into the stretch, angled outside the top two five wide in deep stretch but failed to respond. TAKARIAN (IRE), within easy striking distance while racing in behind the leaders into the stretch, angled six wide in the upper stretch but lacked a late response. BERNSTEIN ducked out at the start bumping JADADA, went up soon after to stalk the leaders four wide, continued forwardly into the stretch but flattened out. AMERICAN TOURIST, six wide on the first turn, failed to rally. IRISH PRIZE, steadied in behind rivals nearing the first turn, was outrun for six furlongs, came out seven wide for the drive but failed to respond. GLICK saved ground while forwardly placed until the second turn and weakened gradually. JADADA, bumped at the start and forced out, followed the leaders in a striking position five wide until the second turn and tired.
