Footnotes

NANNYCAM, never far back and five wide, came a bit wider to make a sweeping run nearing the final quarter, took over and moved well clear under mild hand urging. CAUCUS tracked front-running DARBY'S CHARM four wide, gained even terms for the lead inside the winner in the upper stretch but couldn't match strides late as second best. STRIKE RATE lunged in the air and swerved out at the start, was outrun for a half and raced inside around the turn, came out four wide entering the stretch and offered a mild gain. VIRGINIA MISS, well placed from the outset while four or five wide, was just off the winner for the final furlong and flattened out. AUNT CONNIE well placed in behind horses to the stretch, eased out four or five wide for the drive and was empty. EDIT IT, outrun early and four or five wide, angled seven wide into the stretch and failed to rally. PACIFIC JEWEL was done upon going a half. COZY COED tired early. DARBY'S CHARM gained the lead early, raced three wide, made the pace until approaching the stretch and tired.
