Footnotes

CALAMUS, reluctant to load into the gate, was never far back, edged in four wide to press the pace, took over entering the upper stretch, moved clear and was kept to his task. HALLOWED FLAG, sluggish to begin, raced near the inside, advanced four wide on the turn, was between foes leaving the eighth pole, angled back to the inside in the late going and was all out to earn the place. GRAND TRAVERSE, well placed from the beginning while four or five wide, loomed menacingly in the final furlong but couldn't muster the needed response. SIX IRON drifted out at the start, was never far back, followed the leaders five wide into the final furlong and failed to fire. OVERLAND TRAIL was sent to the fore inside early, made the pace for a half and weakened thereafter. SHAWNEE DANCER, outsprinted early and four wide, failed to offer a closing bid. DISSONANCE raced in contention near the inside for three furlongs and couldn't keep pace. PREACHER BROWN drifted in at the start, raced eight or nine wide most of the way and never menaced. LAUNCH A LEGEND, broke slowly, was shut off and never close. FRONTIER EXPRESS raced forwardly near the inside until nearing the stretch and tired. EXCELLSIOR failed to menace. GATO BANDITO moved inside on the turn and never was prominent.
