TEMPLAR'S CUP stalked the pace three deep, reeled in CREEK BAY entering the stretch, poked his head in front inside the furlong marker and was fully extended to just last. VILLAINAGE attended the pace along the inside, angled out leaving the turn to launch his bid, finished willingly and was getting to the winner with every stride. CREEK BAY pressed the pace on the inside down the backstretch, then two wide through the turn, forged command nearing the furlong marker, battled gamely through a long drive but wasn't quite good enough. BALLACOLLA settled in the second flight, split horses entering the stretch to make his bid and improved his position late. ROMNEY MARSH was unhurried into stride, made a late rally circling four wide but failed to seriously threaten. CHIN HIGH broke a step slow, angled in to save ground, angled out entering the stretch to make a belated gain but was left with too much to do. SULTRY BIDDER set the pressured pace two wide, shook clear after a half and angled in, was headed entering the stretch and gave way. STORMY ATLANTIS failed to respond. KATZMETIC was hustled along in the second flight three wide but failed to menace. ROCKHOUSE ROCKET chased the pace along the inside for six furlongs and dropped out. BROTHER RON was hustled along six wide for a half, stopped and was distanced through the stretch. CITYBOY OR COWBOY was through before going a half and was distanced through the lane.
