NOBLE'S PROMISE close up while three wide and in hand, went after the leaders leaving the turn when asked, gained a short lead with a furlong to go and drew clear under steady urging. BACKTALK reserved three wide, launched his bid entering the stretch, drifted out late under left handed pressure and finished willingly to be up for the place. DON TITO a bit awkward at the start, recovered and was unhurried while within striking distance, moved up four wide on the turn, reached a striking position with a furlong to go but lacked a late bid while carried out a bit late. CLOSE TO THE EDGE pressed the pace off the inside, challenged in earnest approaching the stretch, held on well to the final sixteenth and tired. BULLDOGGER set the pace near the rail, responded willingly when challenged on the turn, battled to midstretch and gave way. COOL BULLET close up while pocketed, was reserved for a half while off the inside and faded in the final quarter. BACKTRACK within striking distance along the inside, came off the rail for the drive and dropped back.
