REGALLY READY was sent up between rivals nearing the turn and engaged RAPPORT for the lead, dueled on a slim advantage nearing the stretch, kicked away in upper stretch, widened a bit a furlong out, responded to brisk urging and held firm. COUNTRY DAY moved up outside entering the turn and gained a stalking position four wide just off the dueling leaders, was under urging around the turn, shifted out wider for the drive and finished with good energy. PERFECT OFFICER saved ground in a forward position, eased out for the drive and rallied between rivals. GREAT ATTACK spurred out to the early lead, rated back off rivals nearing the turn, bobbled and got out briefly near the three eighths pole bothering CALIFORNIA FLAG, HOOFIT and HAVELOCK, recovered to gain along the inside into the stretch, eased out to loom a solid presence in mid stretch then hung late. CARACORTADO, four to five wide advancing around the far turn, raced within range approaching the quarter pole, angled out wider for the drive then lacked the needed response. RAPPORT moved up three wide to take a short lead nearing the turn, dueled outside the winner around the turn, held well to the sixteenth marker. CAMP

VICTORY , sluggish from the gate, angled in near the three eighths pole and had a belated response. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE broke a beat slow, was hustled up five wide into the turn, chased the leaders but failed to generate a significant stretch kick. HOLIDAY FOR KITTEN broke inward and brushed with GRAND ADVENTURE, was steadied along inside through the opening furlong, continued inside into the lane while well off the pace, shifted out and failed to menace. GRAND ADVENTURE , brushed at the break, settled back inside, swung out mid turn but lacked a bid. HOOFIT (NZ) was checked and forced out when put in close near the three eighths pole, raced wide in the drive and could not recover. CALIFORNIA FLAG , between rivals, was checked and carried out near the three furlong marker. BROKEN DREAMS was rated back between rivals early and never menaced. HAVELOCK was checked and forced out leaving the far turn and gave way.
