Footnotes

BO'S SISTER gained the lead early, raced four wide, edged inside when clear entering the turn, made the balance of the pace and was kept to her task. WEEPNOMOREMYLADY bobbed at the break, settled inside, came out leaving the turn, rallied between foes four or five wide at the furlong grounds and finished willingly. SEATTLE LAKE, well placed throughout, lacked a closing account. SARAH'S MUSIC, inside early, eased outside front-running BO'S SISTER to press the pace leaving the backstretch, continued in closest attendance to that one into the final furlong and weakened. CRACK THE BOOKS bobbed at the start, raced in contention near the inside into the stretch and weakened when the test came. ILLUSIVE PLAY, within easy striking distance while following the leaders five or six wide into the stretch, was empty the last eighth. RICHTER'S EMBLEM, well placed four or five wide early, faded steadily on the turn.
