Footnotes

SOME CAME RUNNING, never far back and racing three or four wide the opening half, came out six wide for the drive and was under strong handling to edge clear late. TO THE TEST drifted out at the start bumping TWIST N STROLL, moved up soon after to force the pace three abreast, took over in the upper stretch, then couldn't handle the winner late. TWIST N STROLL, bumped at the start by TO THE TEST, was outsprinted early, made a run four or five wide on the turn, loomed a solid threat for the drive but was empty the last eighth. DONEBROKE swerved in at the start, continued inward to duel with GLORIFY, held on well until the final quarter and weakened. BEE LINE GENIUS, well placed inside for a half, came out four or five wide for the drive, then lacked a final response. GLORIFY broke alertly and maneuvered inside to gain a slim lead, held a slight edge while dueling with DONEBROKE for a half and gradually weakened. BROAD BREADTH had no rally. GO HIGH failed to reach contention. BIG HEADACHE faded approaching the stretch. JANET ROSE was outrun after bobbling at the start. SARATOGA CAT never was close. COBRA SQUEEZE, sluggish to start, was outrun.
