ANGELA'S LOVE, close up inside from early on, rallied from the rail, took over on the turn, edged clear in the upper stretch and widened under mild hand urging. OUR MIMI, never far back, raced in behind the leaders on the turn, moved out between foes three wide into the final furlong and couldn't menace the winner as second best. PARTING, between horses, was five or six wide at the quarter-mile ground and improved position late while not a serious threat. A LITTLE GOLD ducked in at the start and bumped the side of the gate, raced in hand four wide, made a bid into the upper stretch while outside the winner and flattened out. MISS MARY APPLES, outsprinted early, moved inside around the turn, angled four wide for the stretch run, improved position but couldn't threaten. PK'S GAL raced close up early while five wide, but weakened approaching the lane. OSSABAW, in front three wide early, lost the advantage on the turn to the winner and faded.
