WELCOME DANCE opened clear to see the pace, remained unchallenged and led throughout. JAMRAA stalked the pace three wide, was no match for the winner but stayed on well to earn the place. WOODFORD LADY stumbled at the start, was rank to place between horses through the first turn, leveled into stride on the backstretch, advanced between horses and finished willingly to earn the show. LITTLE NIP was allowed to settle, came five wide and finished with a mild rally. NEW WAVE settled between horses, moved out four wide to make a mild bid but failed to sustain the drive. BOURBONSTREETGIRL was forwardly placed three wide, but weakened on the second turn and faded. LA STUPENDA was unhurried four wide and was never a factor. RAZZLEBERRY saved ground to no avail.
