Footnotes

IS SILVER GOOD outrun for three furlongs, made a run three wide thereafter, reeled in the leaders and drew off late. DUBAELE vied for the lead off the inside, dropped back a bit on the turn then came again for the place. TRIO OF MISCHIEF drifted in at the start and steadied, made a good three wide move on the turn, gained a short lead with a furlong to go but tired late. HURRICANE PASS reserved off the inside, was no threat. TAZDUE alternated for the lead three wide, drew clear on the turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. SEVEN SPOT forwardly placed while off the inside, faded. ESCARTO reared at the start, was outrun for a half and was no factor. SUNSHINE KING broke slowly and was outrun. BAD BOB behind the leaders along the inside, faded. DAKOTA FRED sluggish at the start, was outrun inside.
