ANSWER LIVELY settled in good position just behind the early leaders, launched a rally three wide on the turn, accelerated to the front opening a clear advantage in upper stretch, maintained a clear lead into deep stretch and prevailed in a hard drive. ALY'S ALLEY, outrun early, raced well back for six furlongs while saving ground, split rivals entering the stretch then finished well along the inside but could not get up. CAT THIEF checked between horses on the first turn, raced in the middle of the pack along the backstretch, edged closer on the turn and finished willingly between horses to gain a share. DARING GENERAL checked in tight at the start, raced well back for a half, circled five wide on the turn and finished evenly. LEMON DROP KID raced in the middle of the pack between horses while four wide to the turn and lacked a strong closing response. THE GROOM IS RED trailed for most of the way after being pinched back at the start. BUCK TROUT stalked the pace while three wide for a half, made a run from outside to challenge on the turn and faded in the drive. TACTICAL CAT was never a factor while six wide on the turn. MOUNTAIN RANGE never reached contention. NOTEASYBEINGGREEN checked slightly along the inside entering the backstretch, saved ground to the turn and tired. YES IT'S TRUE dueled along the rail to the turn and gave way. RED SEA broke through the gate prior to the start, faded after going five furlongs. TIME BANDIT raced in contention to the turn then gave way and was eased late.
