CROWN OF CRIMSON, forwardly placed between rivals, gained a short lead while three wide and between rivals with three furlongs to go, responded willingly when displaced with a furlong to go then finished with good energy late to be drawing clear. MADDIE'S PROMISE, pressed the early pace outside, raced kindly into the turn when prominent and four wide, gained a short lead outside the winner with a furlong to go but could not keep pace with that one in the final sixteenth. DANCE FOR DIXIE, reserved early when within striking distance, improved her position on the turn, drifted out under left handed pressure with a furlong to go then finished willingly while drifting out again late. ENDLESSLY alternated for the lead inside, came again in midstretch after dropping back a bit then weakened under pressure. FOXCALLER, reserved early near the rail, was angled out five wide with three furlongs to go, made a good run into the stretch but lacked a solid late bid. APOLLO CAT, within striking distance off the inside, was through after five furlongs. ONE BAD CAT raced within striking distance three wide and gave way in the drive. HAIL HOLY QUEEN alternated for the lead off the inside and faded.
