Footnotes

SPECIAL INTEREST, never far back and near the inside for a half, worked his way out four or five wide for the drive, caught front-running BIG CASE a sixteenth out and was hard ridden to edge clear. METALLIC, well placed and racing near the inside throughout, was all out to earn the place. BIG CASE stalked the dueling leaders from early on while four or five wide, gained the edge in the upper stretch but couldn't sustain the needed momentum. STORM ON THE BLOCK gained a slim lead two wide early, battled up close into the lane and weakened. WILD ROLL, outrun for a half, raced five wide into the stretch and managed a minor gain. KANU, outrun early and angled in three wide, remained there wide entering the stretch and improved position while unable to menace. GIANT FUN, outsprinted early and four wide, angled five or six wide into the stretch to make a run but failed to continue. PURE THUNDER, bumped at the start by CHIPINGE, went up to fight for the lead early while three or four wide, battled forwardly until the stretch and weakened. CHIPINGE came out bumping PURE THUNDER at the start and weakened upon going a half. ROVE was always outrun.
