Footnotes

HE'S LONG GONE stalked the pace three wide, forged command nearing the five-sixteenths pole, disputed the issue through a prolonged drive and was fully extended to prevail by the narrowest of margins. GOOD QUESTION set the pressured pace along the inside, was headed on the second turn, came again with renewed vigor through the stretch, battled gamely but was denied in the final stride. INDYAMA JONES settled saving ground, ranged into striking distance off of the inside, angled in and got through entering the stretch but lacked the needed late response. LOCH DUBH was forwardly placed four wide to attend the pace, but weakened during the drive and gave way. GREY LINE EXPRESS broke in a tangle and was away well behind his field, made a belated gain along the inside but was left with too much to do. CATARIAT was hustled along between horses in mid pack and went evenly. LEO LARKSPUR pressed the pace two wide, but weakened from between horses after six furlongs and faded. INKI BLANDFORD settled in the second flight,

made a mild rally four wide but was never a factor. ARDANWOOD was unhurried into stride, came seven wide but passed only his tiring rivals. DIAMOND CLIFF saved ground to no avail. GINGOLD showed little. KENTUCKY STORMIN chased the pace along the inside for a half and stopped.
