Footnotes

BADGER BARRY reserved off the inside, angled out five wide entering the stretch when rallying and closed well to be up in time. STOLEN CHEVY set the early pace, responded when challenged before a half, saved ground on the turn, drew clear in midstretch but was outfinished. HE'S DANGEROUS forwardly placed three wide, lacked the needed closing bid. DEPUTY SREVA far back early, was outrun to the stretch and closed a gap on the outside. NINTH CLIENT within striking distance four wide, lodged a mild late bid. MINER BIRD pressed the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and weakened. BK'S CLEARANCEISLE outrun while off the inside, could not menace. ARTIC CRY forwardly placed in the four path, faded. OAK BAR prominent early near the rail, was eased before a half when lame.
