Footnotes

LAOPE was reserved between horses, worked his way to the outside leaving the turn, came six wide and was fully extended to narrowly prevail. STEVE'S BIG MOE was unhurried into stride, tucked in to save ground, got through every step and was making up ground. U HUSH was close up five wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but weakened following a long drive and settled for the show. SIR JOCK stalked the pace, made his bid four wide, but flattened during the drive. DR. JAJO was allowed to settle, came three wide and improved position. IRVING RULES set the pressured pace along the inside, was collared leaving the turn, drifted out entering the stretch and gave way. BIG BOY CHARLIE was allowed to settle, came eight wide to make a mild bid but

failed to sustain the drive. SIR SHAUN contended off of the inside to the stretch and retreated. SIX PACK ABS showed little. STORM MAKE'N was through after a half. MOCC ME NOW broke a step slow and was outrun. SUYETA contended between horses, bled and was taken up before going a half, was pulled up entering the stretch and was vanned off.
