COLONIAL EMPRESS was bumped at the start and slow into stride, pulled to contention between horses, got through leaving the turn, kicked on strongly once clear and drew away. SHHH settled between horses, came six wide and finished willingly to earn the place. BATTLE BRIDGE was unhurried into stride, got through entering the stretch and was making up ground. SATURDAY BLUES set the pressured pace three wide, disputed the issue to the final furlong and faded. OCEAN BERTIE stalked the pace, moved up four wide to make a bold bid but came up empty during the drive and dropped out. MYLITTLEDEUCECOUPE stumbled and was bumped at the start, settled in hand, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. SMARTLY BRED passed only the tiring ones. SONG OF BERNADETTE pressed the pace between horses, but came up empty leaving the turn and dropped out. BIRD SWING settled off of the inside, but came up empty after six furlongs and retreated. DONE IN LOVE chased six wide for three-quarters of a mile and stopped.
