Footnotes

BOLD CHOICE prompted the pace three wide, took over leaving the second turn, shook clear and widened. IL MOSTRO settled saving ground, advanced between horses through the second turn, got through entering the stretch and finished willingly. SOAPSTONE PRAIRIE set the pressured pace toward the inside, was no match for the winner entering the stretch, weakened further and settled for the show. BALTERSAN contended between horses, shifted out to make his bid but lacked the needed late response. PORTMAN was allowed to settle, circled five wide to range into contention but faltered during the drive. C FOR CHANT was unhurried into stride, angled in and finished with a belated gain. UNCLE TED passed only the tiring ones. DYNAMIC KNIGHT was close up four wide through the second turn and dropped out. BRENT THE BANKER showed little. MUNICIPAL FINANCE was forwardly placed toward the inside but stopped before going six furlongs.
