CHAS'S LEGACY within striking distance four wide, challenged from the three path on the second turn, dropped back a bit into the stretch then came again late. THUNDERGRAM drifted in at the start, set the pace inside, repulsed a pair of bids on the second turn, drew clear once in the stretch but missed. COMMANDING CURVE forwardly placed from the start, raced four wide on the second turn and was gaining late. LONG STATION prompted the pace three wide, challenged between rivals on the second turn but weakened in the drive. AWESOME SKY reserved inside, angled out a bit, was eager behind rivals on the backstretch, raced in traffic into the second turn, came five wide into the stretch and made a late gain. SEAL SIX bobbled after the start, drifted out placing outer rivals in tight, steadied into the first turn behind the leaders, pulled along the rail on the backstretch and tired in the drive. EIRIGH hopped at the start then steadied when in tight, steadied once in the first turn in traffic then was no threat. STRONG TAPIT squeezed at the start, was outrun to the stretch and was no threat. TAPIT TOWN pulled on the first turn when in traffic and close up, raced six wide with three furlongs to go and tired. GENERAL IKE fought restraint on the first turn, raced five wide with three furlongs to go and faded.
