DROGUE pressed the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, took over in midstretch and held sway under steady urging. A. P. INDIAN within striking distance four wide, lodged a mild late bid. FLASHY SUNRISE outrun early, advanced three wide on the second turn and was gaining late. BRADESTER set the pace along the inside, held on well to the final furlong and weakened. BASHAAR tonged in the gate, broke slowly, was outrun to the stretch and showed late interest. SON OF A GENERAL reserved off the inside, could not threaten. QUIET MAN forwardly placed three wide, tired. GOSPEL LESSON prominent early, raced in the three path on the second turn and stopped.
