Footnotes

HATTIESBURG leaned in early bumping ROAD QUEEN, settled behind foes within striking distance, came out five or six wide for the drive, caught front-running CARRY ISLE leaving the eighth pole and won going away under strong handling. CARRY ISLE sprinted clear early, edged inside, made the pace into the final furlong and wasn't a match for HATTIESBURG. CURVE AHEAD, outsprinted early, rallied six or seven wide into the stretch, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but lacked a further account. CREATIVITY, well placed three or four wide between foes into the stretch, was empty when the test came. ROAD QUEEN, bumped at the start and steadied, made a mild bid to reach contention in the upper stretch but lacked a further response. PRINCESS OMAR saved ground but failed to rally. VALIANT FIGHTER, wide early, was never prominent. JUDITH ANN tired early. GOLF WIDOW was outrun. I'M TALKIN' TOO pressed front-running CARRY ISLE for a half, gave way and wasn't persevered with when hopelessly beaten.
