**Footnotes**

DEVIL TIME, reserved inside soon after the start, saved ground until the final quarter, came out six wide for the drive and closed rapidly to wear down LIKE TO TALK in the closing yards. LIKE TO TALK, never far back and saving ground throughout, rallied along the rail into the stretch, came through close quarters to reach the front right at the eighth pole, briefly was clear, then failed to last. CONSCIENCE CLEAR, forwardly placed between rivals from the beginning, edged up to stick a head in front between calls entering the upper stretch, then weakened the last eighth. TWO POINT TWO MILL, unhurried early and maneuvered inside, saved ground until approaching the stretch, came out to rally from between rivals four or five wide, loomed a solid threat for the last eighth but lacked a response. KEEP ROLL'N gained the lead, raced in hand while moving inside, made the pace into the upper stretch and weakened. NEWSPEAK drifted out a the start bumping A. P. DELTA. was checked, settled thee or four wide in a striking position, came out a bit farther on the course for the drive but was empty late. HIT THE HARDWOOD failed to menace. A. P. DELTA, bumped by NEWSPEAK at the start and checked, recovered to gain a position five wide, raced in contention for six furlongs and weakened gradually. EIGHTIES was outrun. ART CONTEMPORAIN (FR) tracked the pace four wide for six furlongs and faded.
