**Footnotes**

THE HESS EXPRESS settled in behind the dueling leaders early while three wide, came out five or six wide entering the stretch, wrested command and widened a bit late under intermittent urging. HAZINO contested the pace early while outside of GROWTH STOCK four or five wide, gained a slim lead on the turn, then wasn't a match for the winner in the drive. GROWTH STOCK gained a slim lead early while dueling inside of HAZINO three wide, lost the edge to that one just prior to going a half, then weakened. CROUPIER, in contention while saving ground throughout, never rallied. PRIZED AMBITION, outrun near the inside until near the stretch, swung out four or five wide for the drive and failed to rally. MYSTICS BLUE ROSE, three or four wide while outsprinted for a half, came out six wide for the drive but offered no closing account.
