**Footnotes**

FLYING MARLIN, reserved in behind horses early, eased out six wide entering the stretch, then closed gamely to earn a narrow decision. BOANA (GER), within easy striking distance while racing in behind horses to the stretch, split foes three or four wide, was inside the winner while three wide in the late going and wasn't quite good enough. RUTLEDGE DANCER, outrun to the far turn and near the inside, edged closer inside approaching the stretch, swung out seven wide when straightened for the drive and slowly was gaining. BLUEBIRD DAY (IRE) stalked front-running SO WELCOME while three or four wide, moved to the fore in the upper stretch, then weakened in the final sixteenth. SWEETMILK CREEK, never far back while following the leaders four or five wide into the stretch, flattened out when the test came. SCORCHING, outrun to the end of the backstretch and five wide, continued five or six wide into the stretch and improved position while unable to seriously menace. DIXIE SCHIC, well placed between rivals three or four wide until the final quarters, weakened in the drive. SO WELCOME gained the lead early, raced in the three path, moved well clear on the backstretch, showed the way to the stretch and tired. DANGEROUS GIRL was outrun. DOC'S HONEY, in contention inside until approaching the stretch, weakened thereafter.
