TACTICAL WEAPON gained the lead early, moved near the inside, was clear into the upper stretch, then lasted under urging. DON'TWAIT TOOLONG settled inside early, was unhurried, lacked room along the rail around the far turn, was clear about the quarter-mile ground and finished full of run. NARTHAX, forwardly placed in behind the winner early, eased out three or four wide for the drive, loomed boldly but wasn't good enough. IMPRESSIVE COMMAND, within striking distance and three wide to the head of the stretch, flattened out in the final furlong. MASS raced in contention five or six wide most of the way but was empty in the drive. MALABAR BAY tracked the pace four or five wide and weakened nearing the stretch. STRONG AMBITION moved near the inside early, eased out a bit leaving the second turn but never fired. MISSIONS DREAM wasn't a factor. TRUMAN'S ADVICE angled in early, pressed the winner for six furlongs and faltered. SUBVERSIVE ACTION dwelt, then hopped at the break and was outrun. CAPTAIN CAREY never was prominent. LISSELAN RIGHTCALL tired entering the far turn.
