Footnotes

FIRE ALARM within striking distance off the rail, angled out three wide late on the turn when rallying, challenged once in the stretch and drew off under mild encouragement. FAIR DINKUM closest to the pace off the inside, challenged before a half, gained a short lead approaching the stretch and held on to be second best. ADMIRAL NELSON outrun for a half, raced three wide on the turn, angled out for the drive and improved his position while no threat. SOUND EFFECT forwardly placed three wide, tired. SNEAKIN AWAY close up in the three path, faded. FLEURDEFORTYFOUR set the pace, saved ground on the turn and faded in the drive. SANTONIO D'ORO was no threat while off the inside.
