Footnotes

MILLENNIA settled saving ground, advanced between horses through the second turn, got through entering the stretch, reeled in the leaders and edged clear. HALLOWEEN PARTY was unhurried into stride, took closer order through the second turn, angled out entering the stretch but found her best stride too late. DAWN LANE set the pressured pace off of the inside, was unable to match strides with the winner, then just failed to hold the place. FLEUR DE LILLY attended the pace four wide, loomed a danger entering the stretch but lacked the needed late kick. AQUAPAZZA contended between horses but flattened entering the stretch. SOFT WHISPER disputed the pace four wide, but faltered between horses in the final furlong and faded. DISTORTED LOVE contended along the inside through the second turn and tired. GLOBE TROT was unhurried in hand and was never a factor. CHARMING SHE IS stumbled at the start, was unhurried into stride, was taken up to avoid the stricken rival, eased to the wire but walked off. JIGGY JO contended four wide for five furlongs, went wrong and fell inside the three-eighths pole and was vanned off. The Stewards conducted an inquiry into the run through the second turn of JIGGY JO, but following the review made no change to the order of finish.
