Footnotes

SUAVE angled in early to press front-running GOLDEN GLEN three or four wide, inched to the front just before going six furlongs, opened a clear lead, then was fully extended to last. BREAKAWAY, outrun for a half, worked his way inside, rallied from the rail entering the stretch and was getting to the winner at the end. FATHER PARTY, always well placed, loomed prominently into the final furlong while between foes four wide but couldn't produce the needed response. INDY, within easy striking distance, lacked a closing account. GOLDEN GLEN gained the lead early, moved inside, made the pace for almost six furlongs and weakened thereafter. TOTALLY PLATINUM, checked repeatedly on the first turn and outrun for six furlongs, made a mild bid into the upper stretch and failed to continue. MAYTOWN unseated the rider behind the gate and briefly delayed the start. During the running, MAYTOWN raced in a striking position five or six wide into the lane and was empty. VICTORYTONITEHEY, sluggish to start and squeezed back, was steadied on the first turn and failed to threaten. ORGANIZING CHAOS wasn't a factor. ELEVEN STARS tracked the pace four wide for six furlongs and tired. KING OF THE VALLEY, steadied in behind rivals approaching the first turn, faded after a half. SMITHTOWN ROAD was outrun.
