GOLDEN MARLIN came out at the break bumping SWEETWATER PROMISE, gained a slim lead inside, accomplished a modest opening half while in hand, was displaced on the front-end just before going six furlongs, regained the advantage in the upper stretch and prevailed under hand urging. MINISTER'S BABY stalked the pace four wide, reached the front briefly between calls at the quarter-mile ground, raced outside the winner through the drive and wasn't good enough. SWEETWATER PROMISE bumped by the winner at the start and squeezed back, settled inside, made a bid from between horses four wide entering the final furlong and couldn't sustain the needed momentum. SECONDARY SCHOOL, well placed inside early, eased out four wide leaving the backstretch, remained within easy striking distance but failed to rally. THERE RUNS HATTIE ducked out at the start bumping PRINCESS PALEFACE, pressed the winner three wide, reached the front just before going six furlongs and weakened in the drive. PRINCESS PALEFACE, bumped at the start, failed to threaten.
