GAFF went up early to press front-running MIDDLE EARTH three or four wide, took over entering the upper stretch, drew clear and continued under brisk urging. SOCIAL PROBATION, outsprinted early and four wide, angled to the rail when straightened into the stretch and was up for the place. MIDDLE EARTH gained the lead early, raced near the inside, made the pace to the stretch and weakened. HOLE IN THE HEAD, well placed while stalking the pace five wide to the stretch, flattened out in the drive. COPY MY NOTES, outrun to the stretch near the inside, came out four or five wide the drive and improved position. BRIDESMAN raced forwardly near the inside for a half and weakened. COWBOY HARDWARE, in contention five or six wide for a half, came eight wide into the stretch and was empty. CASUAL CAT tracked the early pace five wide and faded nearing the final quarter.
