Footnotes

DARING JULIE, never far back, advanced from between foes three or four wide into the stretch, was bumped in the late going by BLUEGRASS BREEZE when that one came out and was along in time. BLUEGRASS BREEZE gained the lead early, moved near the inside, came out bumping the winner in the final sixteenth and couldn't last. PIANO TUNNER, within striking distance and near the inside into the stretch, eased out three wide for the drive, angled back closer to the inside very late but couldn't make up the difference. LIVELY CLASSIC, never far back and in behind the leaders four wide, lacked a final account. COME ON CATHY ANN, reluctant to load into the gate, was outrun near the inside to the stretch, worked her way out between foes five wide in the late going and improved position. IMAFLASHYCAT forced the pace into the final furlong while four or five wide and weakened. GOLD SPIKE, within easy striking distance to the stretch and four or five wide, came up empty. DEBS JETT leaned at the start bumping TRANSPARENCY, went up to track the pace five wide, remained a threat into the final furlong and weakened. ARTFUL LAUNCH, outrun five wide to the lane, came out eight abreast but never threatened. TRANSPARENCY, bumped at the start by DEBS JETT, failed to seriously menace. A FOUL CLAIM LODGED BY THE RIDER OF BLUEGRASS BREEZE AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS DISALLOWED.
