Footnotes

LIFE'S GREAT, within easy striking distance while tracking the leaders four or five wide, inched to the front in the upper stretch, then was hard ridden to hold sway. UNKATZABLE, in hand along the inside for six furlongs and never far back, lost a bit of position in the upper stretch, angled between foes five wide and closed well to earn the place. CLASSICAL RYDER, outrun three wide to the lane, swung out six wide for the drive and was going well at the end. SUN SPUN went up early to press front-running SACRED FEATHER, gained a slight edge leaving the the turn but gradually weakened in the last eighth. PLATINEE tracked the pace from early on while three or four wide, was well placed into mid-stretch and flattened out. SHESANIDEM moved in three wide early, continued from the rail into the late going but failed to respond. SACRED FEATHER gained the advantage early, maneuvered near the inside, made the pace for three-quarters and was finished. REMIEWATERBLUZ raced four or five wide most of the way and weakened. COUNTRY FAIR (UAE) was outrun.
