BIG TALL PAUL behind the leaders, commenced his rally three wide on the turn and rallied willingly to be up in time. LAMBEAU pressed the pace three wide, challenged in midstretch and held on gamely. OLYMPIST squeezed back at the start, was outrun early, made a run four wide on the turn and was gaining on the outside. FIRST GOLD lost his footing at the start, drifted in recovering bumping STAGE SUCCESS in the process, vied for the lead inside, took over before a half, led the field to the final furlong and tired. STAGE SUCCESS bumped in at the start, was reserved early, raced in the three path on the turn and could not threaten. YO COLTRANE set the pace off the inside, held on well to the stretch and tired. MAX THE KNIFE was no threat while off the inside. J T KINGFISHER within striking distance inside, stopped.
