Footnotes

WINKATDAWAT stalked the pace four wide, forged command nearing the furlong marker, dug in gamely and kept HARBORPLACE at bay. HARBORPLACE settled between horses, angled out five wide leaving the turn, loomed large entering the stretch, continued on willingly but was unable to bridge the gap. JANUARY BEE prompted the pace between horses, weakened during the drive but had enough left to just hold the show. INDUCE set the pressured pace off of the inside, faltered during the drive and drifted about as his faded. FORTY NINE WATTS was allowed to settle five wide, finished with a belated gain but failed to threaten. DISCUSSION CLOSED contended along the inside, got through entering the stretch but came up empty in the drive. WHAT A LOOSECANNON was unhurried into stride, stopped leaving the turn, was eased to the wire but walked off. SUYETA lagged at the tail of the field, bled and was pulled up leaving the turn, and was vanned off.
