ANGRY MOON forwardly placed three wide, responded willingly in the stretch, wore down the leader and prevailed. COMMANDMENT drifted in at the start and steadied, was outrun for a half, came four wide into the stretch and closed fast. ONE MORE NIGHT behind the leaders off the inside, responded willingly in the stretch, rallied in company with the winner while inside that one, then drifted in late forcing DOUBLY DISTINCT in in the closing yards. DOUBLY DISTINCT drifted in at the start and bumped STREET CHIEF, vied for the lead off the inside, drew clear once in the stretch and held on well while forced in in the closing yards. BLUEBLEND reserved early, raced three wide on the turn and made a good late gain. STREET CHIEF bumped at the start, was outrun to the stretch and made a late gain. FLAT IN CHARGE trailed to the stretch five wide and showed late interest. BREWING alternated for the lead along the inside, held on well to midstretch and tired. ZIP TRIP forwardly placed in the four path, gave way. RAGING MARKET five wide on the turn, was no threat. YANKEE DIME within reach while off the inside, gave way. A FOUL CLAIM BY THE RIDER OF DOUBLE DISTINCT AGAINST THE RIDER OF ONE MORE NIGHT FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED.
