ABACO bothered at the start, was outrun early three wide, advanced in that path on the second turn, angled out for the drive and closed well to be up late. MIZ IDA reserved along the inside, made a good middle move along the rail, gained a short lead from the inside with a furlong to go and held on gamely. SOLID APPEAL closet to the pace three wide, reeled in the leader after five furlongs, gained a short lead with a quarter mile to go and also held on gamely. STARSTRUCK (IRE) outrun early, angled out and made a good run from the five furlong marker to the three eighths pole, challenged approaching the stretch but weakened. SOMALI LEMONADE drifted out at the start tightening up the winner, was straightened to be forwardly placed, made a run to challenge from the four path after six furlongs but weakened in the drive. STREET OF GOLD reserved along the inside, made a good move to the quarter mile marker but had little left late. MY PERFECT TEN drifted in at the start and bumped the winner after being bumped by RARE EVENT, was reserved for a half, made a good move off rail on the second turn but tired in the drive. SOFT WHISPER sprinted to a long lead while out in the three path, moved in a bit on the second turn, held on well to the stretch and tired. RARE EVENT drifted in at the start and bumped MY PERFECT TEN, was forwardly placed three wide and faded. EMBARR was outrun.
