HARD ACES forwardly placed from the start, challenged four wide on the second turn, took over in midstretch, responded willingly when challenged by the runner up inside the final furlong and proved best while fully expended. PICK OF THE LITTER within striking distance inside, came off the inside on the backstretch, angled out for the drive challenged the winner inside the final furlong but missed. MOSHAAGIB outrun early, made a bold five wide middle move, reached closest to the winner in midstretch but weakened. POSITIVELY broke in the air, recovered to be close up three wide, challenged from that path on the second turn, held on well to the final furlong and tired. DIPSY DREW pressed the pace off the inside, challenged in earnest on the second turn but tired in the drive. ARGOSY lost his footing a bit at the start, was outrun early, raced five wide on the second turn and was no threat. HE BE SOMETHIN within striking distance, raced three wide on the second turn and tired in the drive. FRASERO (ARG) within reach in the three path, raced four wide on the second turn and gave way. SILVER ANTELOPE sprinted clear and angled in, set the pace along the inside and faded in the stretch.
