Footnotes

WATCH settled in hand early while three wide in behind horses, moved between foes nearing the final quarter, came out five wide for the drive and was ridden hard to prevail. SITKA, outrun for six furlongs while four of five wide, came out seven wide when straightened for the drive and was going well at the end. GINO'S SPIRITS (GB), rated near the inside early, saved ground entering the stretch, lacked room at the eighth pole, eased out between foes a sixteenth out and couldn't make up the difference. IOYA TWO gained a narrow advantage early while dueling inside of ALYBGOOD, drew clear on the backstretch, made the pace into the final furlong and faltered. CLEARLY A QUEEN, reserved inside early, was asked for speed leaving the three-furlong marker, eased out four wide into the upper stretch, was checked between horses when lacking room approaching the final sixteenth and lacked a late response. BABAE (CHI) bobbed in her second stride, worked her way inward soon after to track the pace four wide, continued prominently until the final quarter and weakened. BINALEGEND settled five wide between foes early while unhurried, edged in a bit on the second turn, angled out five wide for the drive but failed to offer a closing account. ALYBGOOD, bumped at the start by LAPUMA, went up soon after to contest the pace outside of IOYA TWO, continued in closest attendance to the one until the stretch and tired. LAPUMA broke outside at the start and bumped ALYBGOOD, raced in a contending position five wide to the far turn and tired.
