Footnotes

FREEFOURINTERNET, bumped at the start, settled in behind horses, moved nearer to the rail approaching the stretch, continued inside, reached the front approaching the final furlong and drove clear late. BAIL OUT THE KING, close up between foes from early on, battled into the final furlong but couldn't match strides with the winner late. TUBROK, never far back while tracking the pace four or five wide, reached the front just before going a half, made the pace into the stretch and grudgingly weakened. DELL PLACE, rated in behind the leaders from early on, raced within easy striking distance three wide but flattened out in the final sixteenth. HONOR IN WAR came out at the start bumping FREEFOURINTERNET, settled inside, continued inside for six furlongs, came out six wide when straightened for the drive but lacked a late response. SPOTTED OWL, outrun early, followed the leaders five wide, reached easy striking distance entering the far turn, continued forwardly into the stretch and flattened out when the test came. SHUAILAAN JENNINGS gained the lead early, maneuvered near the inside, lost the edge just prior to going a half to TUBROK, then weakened after five furlongs. TALKMEISTER hopped at the start and never was a factor.
