Footnotes

SIBERIAN LILY, away well between foes, settled inside on the backstretch, rallied from, the rail, accelerated to the front when asked at the furlong grounds and was hard ridden the remainder. GOLDEN KNOLLS tracked the pace four wide, made a bold run to reach the front briefly at the eighth pole but wasn't good enough at the end. SARAH'S MAGIC, outrun for a half and three or four wide, came out six or seven wide for the drive and finished well. SHE'S INDY MONEY, within easy striking distance three wide, maneuvered five or six wide for the drive and managed a mild gain. SWEETDOWNTHELANE broke in the air, bobbled when landing, raced three or four wide into the stretch and finished evenly. SUNSHINE STATE gained the lead inside early, showed the way to the head of the stretch and weakened. SARATOGA DRIVE failed to menace. CLASH raced four or five wide and was outrun. WILDCAT FAN forced the pace three or four to the upper stretch and gradually weakened.
